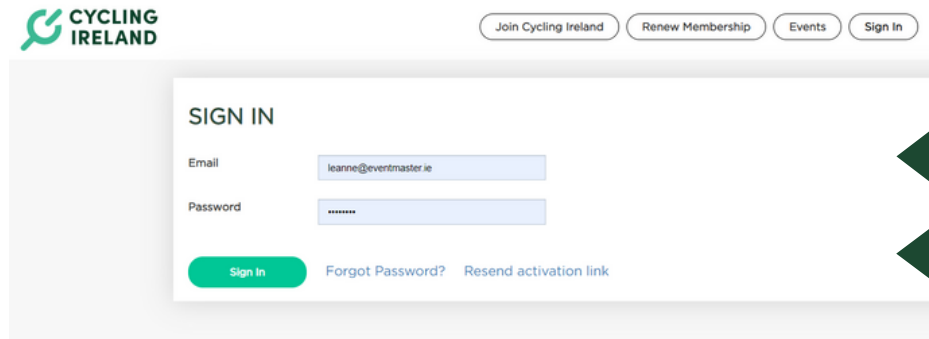


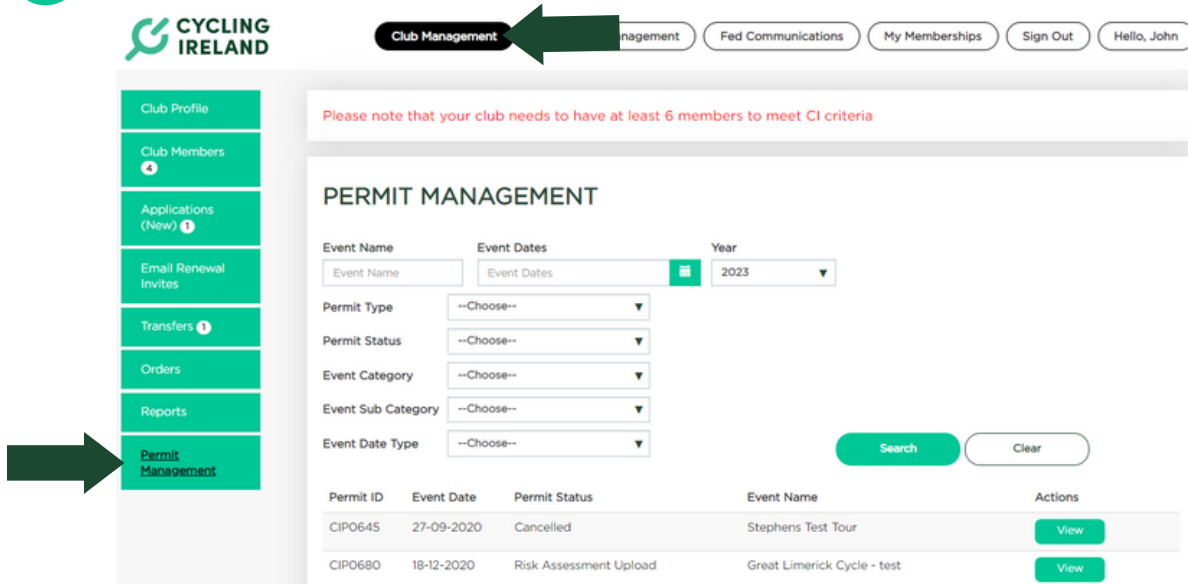
# Applying for a Permit



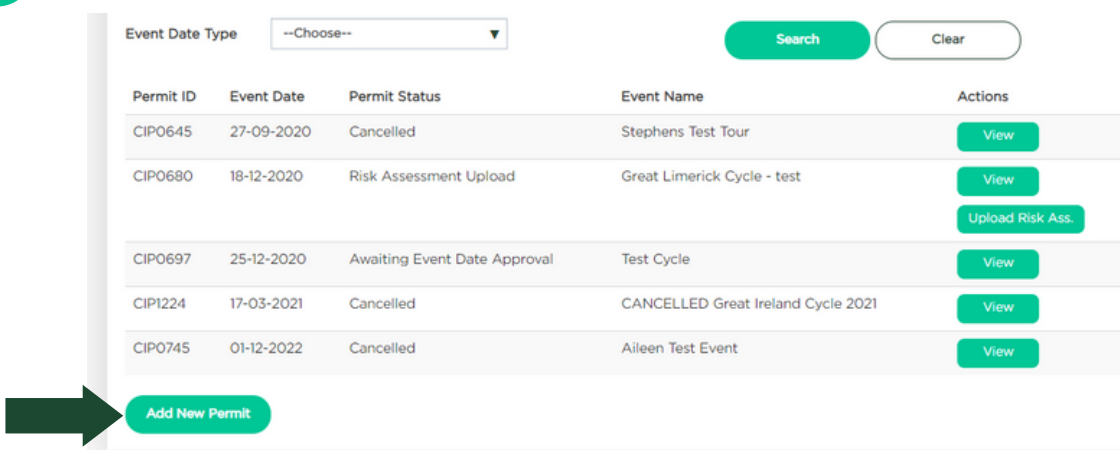
**1** Log in with your CLUB email and password [Here](#)

This information will automatically set up a draft event for online registration through the Eventmaster platform.

Read and accept the terms & conditions to proceed.

## Applying for a Permit



### Permit Approval Process

Your event permit will go through a number of steps before being open for online booking.

- **Awaiting Event date approval** – The date of your event will be approved by regional/federation user. If your event date is declined, we will contact you about alternative dates.
- **Upload Risk Assessment** – Your event date has been approved and you are invited to upload your risk assessment. At this stage, Leisure events can open for online bookings.
- **Awaiting Risk Assessment Approval** – Your Risk Assessment is being checked. If it is declined your status will return to 'Upload risk assessment' and we will be in touch with reason(s) as to why it was declined.
- **Approved** - Your event is fully approved and sanctioned by Cycling Ireland. Competitive events can open for online booking. The Cycling Ireland events team will give you administrative access to the event within the Eventmaster ticketing platform.
