<b>Category:</b>	<b>International Carding Scheme Criteria for 2011</b>
Podium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medallist in the World Championships</li> <li>• Medallist in the Olympic Games</li> <li>• 1-3 Overall in any European Pro Tour event or Major Tours (Giro Femine or La Route de France for women) See events listed in Appendix A</li> <li>• 1-3 Points or KOH competition in one of the Grand Tours (Giro Femine or La Route de France for women)</li> </ul>
World Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4-12 in the World Championships</li> <li>• 4-12 in the Olympic Games</li> <li>• 1-10 Overall in any European Pro Tour event (<i>and women's equivalent of pro tour</i>)</li> </ul>

**NOTES:**

Once an athlete has been on the Carding Scheme for 5 years, their application will be reviewed on an annual basis. All athletes must continue to show improvement to remain of the Carding Scheme.

***Performance Incentive Payment Criteria for Road Cycling***

<i>Podium</i>	<i>Medal in World or Olympic Games, podium place at a monument event</i>
<i>World Class</i>	<i>Win in a UCI 1.HC or 2.HC event (GC)</i>
<i>International</i>	<i>Winner of UCI 2.1 or 1.1 event (GC)</i>
<i>Developmental</i>	<i>Developmental – Winner in a UCI 2.2 or 1.2 event (GC)</i>

Athletes can only qualify for a PIP payment based on their original qualification for inclusion on the Carding scheme

**NOTES:**

All track times to be achieved under competition conditions.

Squad funding is based on being a member of a team that achieves the agree criteria above, for a specific event. ISC will allocate up to 8 Cards for the Men's team and up to 6 Cards to the Women's team. To continue to receive funding, athletes must remain part of the relevant team.

**Performance Incentive Payment Criteria for Track Cycling**

Podium	Medal in World or Olympic Games
World Class	Winner of a TT in a UCI Protour event
International	Winner of a World Cup event (individual)
Developmental	Medallist in a World Cup event (individual) or top 3 UCI Individual TT

**NOTES:**

Athletes can only qualify for a PIP payment based on their original qualification for inclusion on the Carding scheme, either as an individual or part of a team.

<b>SPORT: PARALYMPIC CYCLING</b>	
<b>Category</b>	<b>International Carding Scheme Criteria for 2011</b>
Contracted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medallist in the Paralympic Games or UCI World Cycling Championships in Paralympic disciplines and events</li> <li>• Number 1 in the end of year UCI World Ranking List in Paralympic disciplines and events</li> </ul>
World Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Placed 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> in the Paralympic Games or UCI World Cycling Championships in Paralympic disciplines and events and within 3% of the bronze medal mark achieved at that event</li> <li>• Nos. 2-4 in the end of year UCI World Ranking List in Paralympic disciplines and events</li> </ul>
International	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Placed 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> in the Paralympic Games or UCI World Cycling Championships in Paralympic disciplines and events and within 6% of the bronze medal mark achieved at that event</li> <li>• Selection for the Paralympic Games</li> <li>• Medallist in the UCI Paracycling World Cup or UCI P1 Category Cycling Championships in Paralympic disciplines and events with a field size of at least 8 competitors.</li> <li>• Nos. 4-10 in the end of year UCI World Rankings in Paralympic disciplines and events and in the top 50% of the ranking list</li> </ul>

<b>Tandem Pilot Position</b>
Tandem Pilot position to receive the equivalent level of carding that applies to the Visually Impaired athlete for which they have been selected to pilot.

<i>Developmental</i>	<i>Bronze Medal in a UCI P1 or World Cup event</i>
