CYCLING IRELAND ROAD COMMISSION CALENDAR **CRITERIA AND TIMELINE FOR 2011 CALENDAR**

In accordance with Cycling Ireland Technical Regulations Chapter G8-Calendar, Applications will be made on the 2011 Standard Application Form only, to the four regional calendar coordinators at the following address':

- Leinster Events: Angelo O'Connor, Station Road, Portarlinton, Co. Laois
- Ulster Events: Marian Lamb, 16 Camlin Park, Crumlin, Co. Antrim. BT9 4HE
- Munster Events: Dan Curtin, Coolageela, Kanturk, Co. Cork
- Connacht Events: Denis Middleton, Apt 2, The Square, Claremorris, Co. Mayo.

The Regional Calendar Coordinators will date and initial each application on the date of arrival. These will be filed in strict order and will be viewed in the order they are received.

Completion of every field marked * on the 2011 Standard Application Form is **MANDATORY**. Any incomplete forms will be returned to event organizer thus delaying obtaining a date on the 2011 calendar of events and possibly losing the date to another event.

Any potential clashes of dates within the same region will be resolved by the Regional Calendar Coordinators with the Road Commission by any means necessary taking into account Commissaires Reports on the events, promotion of separate category races and promotion of Youth Racing.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE FOR APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for all Road Racing Events are invited from September 13th 2010 until October 15th 2010. A meeting of the four Regional Calendar Coordinators and members of the Cycling Ireland Road Commission will be held on Sunday October 24th 2010. Regional Calendar Coordinators will submit their Regions drafts and any potential clashes will be resolved. All events on the submitted drafts **MUST** be accompanied by the 2011 Road Event Application Form.

Only the Drafts Submitted on this day will be entered onto the Cycling Ireland Handbook.

It is then intended that an accurate draft of the 2011 Calendar will be available for viewing at the 2010 Cycling Ireland AGM, before going to print.

LATE APPLICATION FORMS

Any late event applications, after the final closing date will be submitted on the 2011 Standard Application Form to Secretary Road Commission, Cycling Ireland. This must be accompanied by written confirmation of any event organizers which the event may clash with on the proposed date in an adjacent province. The Road Commission will seek approval from the Board of Cycling Ireland in accordance with Chapter G8.6

NOTE: Regardless of how soon after the closing date for applications, late applications will not be included on the published calendar of events for 2011.

The Board of Cycling Ireland will have the final say on any event applications.

All organizers are reminded of Chapter G8.8 :

Where a race is cancelled after the publication of the final race calendar, then the promoting club may be liable for a fine, not exceeding €100. The exact amount will be on the recommendation of the Cycling Ireland Treasurer and will be subject to Board Approval.

Safety code

Cycling Ireland will be issuing a template of a Safety Code which **MUST** be completed for all promotions on the 2011 Calendar. The time frame for which the safety code must be submitted to Cycling Ireland will be announced shortly.
